Bay Beach Wildlife Sanctuary

is a beautiful 600 acre urban wildlife refuge open year round featuring live animal exhibits, educational displays, miles of hiking/skiing trails and various wildlife viewing opportunities. Started in 1936 as a waterfowl rehabilitation refuge, Bay Beach Wildlife Sanctuary R-PAWS rehabilitation program admits over 5300 orphaned, ill, and injured animals from the public annually. Winter and snow brings beautiful cross-country trails. The captive animal displays and Animal Ambassador Education program highlights the nearly 200 permanently injured animals that call the Bay Beach Wildlife Sanctuary home!

Be sure to bring your skis to enjoy the free, groomed trails or join us over lunch for a hike and tour of either the BBWLS rehab program or behind the scenes of the Captive Wildlife program, including BBWLS's unique wolf pack!
