**Mosquito Hill Nature Center**

The Mosquito Hill Nature Center is a part of the Outagamie County Park System. It is open year round with both indoor and outdoor opportunities on 430 acres adjacent to the Wolf River. Inside are natural history exhibits, hands-on displays, a gift shop, themed classrooms, meeting rooms, and a library. A trail system for hiking or walking includes three miles of developed trails with a loop to scenic vistas on one of the highest elevation points in the area. When the snow season arrives, one un-groomed cross-country skiing trail and five miles of snowshoe trails can provide winter enjoyment!

**Be sure to bring your snowshoes or rent them there for a great hike over lunch!**
